GENERAL REASSESSMENT FOR REAL PROPERTY  
TAZEWELL COUNTY, VIRGINIA

Tazewell County, Virginia is accepting written proposals to perform a General Reassessment in accordance with Section 58.1-3252 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended. The appraisal firm shall make a complete uniform General Reassessment of all real property within the County of Tazewell, including mineral lands and minerals under development, excluding public service corporation properties and non-carrier railroad properties, but including an inventory of all non-taxable properties and the classification of all real property in accordance with State statutes. The successful proposer will be asked to provide the services contained within the "Explanation of Procedures and Scope of Services". Sealed proposals shall be submitted to the Tazewell County Administrator's Office, 108 E. Main St, Tazewell, Virginia 24651, by May 20, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. The envelope must be clearly marked "Sealed Proposal-County Reassessment" with a return address shown. All proposals received after the specified date and time will be returned unopened.
