## **Instructions for Erosion and Sediment Control Applications**

- Filing Deadline: Erosion and Sediment Control applications must be submitted to the Department
  of Engineering at least 10 calendar days prior to the Planning Commission meeting. Failure to
  submit all required information and plans by the filing deadline will result in the application being
  deferred to a later date. Note: the Planning Commission meets the second Thursday of each
  month.
- 2. **Application Forms:** Complete all parts of the application form using black ink or type. Sign the form, and include a daytime telephone number.
- Narrative/Site Plan: Applicants must submit 10 paper copies and a digital copy of the proposed Narrative/Site Plan with the application. Narratives/Site Plans which do not comply with the minimum requirements of the Tazewell County Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance will be denied.
- 4. **Filing Fee:** The filing fee is a Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) application fee and then Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per disturbed acre rounded to the nearest acre.
- 5. Bond: The applicant will be required to submit a Performance Guarantee bond to Tazewell County In the amount specified by The Tazewell County Engineering Department. The Performance Guarantee amount will be provided to the applicant once The Erosion and Sediment Control application is approved.
