

The Board of Supervisors of Tazewell County, in regular meeting on the 5/6/2025 adopted the following:

RESOLUTION FOR RURAL RUSTIC ROAD DESIGNATION

WHEREAS, §33.2-332 of the Code of Virginia, permits the hard surfacing of certain unpaved roads deemed to qualify for designation as a Rural Rustic Road; and

WHEREAS, any such road must be located in a low-density development area and have no more than 1,500 vehicles per day; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Tazewell County, Virginia (“Board”) desires to consider whether the following route, should be designated Rural Rustic Road; and

- Route 739 (Tin Can Alley):
 - From intersection with Route 19 (Steelsburg Highway) to end of state maintenance, length = 1-mile.

WHEREAS, the Board is unaware of pending development that will significantly affect the existing traffic on this road; and

WHEREAS, the public has been made aware that this road is to be paved with minimal improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that this road should be designated as Rural Rustic Roads due to its qualifying characteristics; and

WHEREAS, this road is in the Board’s six-year plan for improvements to the secondary system of state highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board hereby designates the road named herein and shown on the attached sketch as a Rural Rustic Road, pursuant to §33.2-332 of the Code of Virginia, and requests that the Local Manager for the Virginia Department of Transportation concur in this designation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board requests that this road be hard surfaced and, to the fullest extent prudent, be improved within the existing right-of-way and ditch-lines to preserve as much as possible the adjacent trees, vegetation, side slopes, and rural rustic character along the roads in their current state.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Resident Engineer for the Virginia Department of Transportation.

APPROVAL OF SECONDARY HIGHWAY SIX YEAR PLAN (2026/27 THROUGH 2031/32)
AND CONSTRUCTION PRIORITY LIST (2026/27)
TAZEWELL COUNTY, VIRGINIA

WHEREAS, Sections 33.1-23 and 33.1-23.4 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, provides the opportunity for each county to work with the Virginia Department of Transportation in developing a Secondary Six-year Road Plan, and

WHEREAS, this Board had previously agreed to assist in the preparation of this Plan, in accordance with the Virginia Department of Transportation policies and procedures and participated in a public hearing on the proposed Plan (2026/27 through 2031/ 32) as well as the Construction Priority List (2026/27) on May 5, 2026, after duly advertised so that all citizens of the County had the opportunity to participate in said hearing and to make comments and recommendations concerning the proposed Plan and Priority List, and

WHEREAS, Lebanon Residecncy representatives, Virginia Department of Transportation, appeared before the Board and recommended approval of the Six-year plan for Secondary Roads FY 2027 through FY 2032 and the Construction Priority List (2026/27) for Tazewell County, Virginia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Supervisors of Tazewell County, Virginia that since said Plan appears to be in the best interest of the Secondary Road System in Tazewell County and of the citizens residing on the Secondary System, said Secondary Six-year plan (2026/27 through 2031/32) and Construction Priority List (2026/27) are hereby approved as presented at the public hearing.
